Personal traits: Hard-working, team player, trustworthy, calm under pressure. Don 't talk trash about your former coworkers or boss. Instead, try to keep it as professional as possible, and think of something that affected patient care or the nursing team, such as a time when a coworker obstructed workflow for the team, or arrived late, or didn 't give proper report.
