The "A, An, The" Rule, when an unsigned article or title begins with the word "A, An, The", alphabetize according to the word after; example "A Shot to the Heart" would be alphabetized under "S" for "Shot"

- Authors' names are inverted (Last name, First name); for each additional author, use traditional name order.
- Every line after the first must be indented one inch (hit Tab key once).
- All entries must include the medium in which the source was produced, delivered, or published.
